- Program Updates:
 - o Part-time Career Advisor at Salinas Adult School will be posted today
 - Student Equity Funds and AEBG Hartnell Hiring a new Pathways Program Coordinator
 - Hartnell Starting new Non Credit ESL Classes
- Plans
 - 17-18 Annual Plan that was submitted August 15 was approved by the State.
 - Vote to approve changes to member plans
 - Action Item: Vote to approve new classes to be offered by North Monterey: Adult Basic Literacy Class, Food Safety Class, and Basic Computer Literacy Class in partnership with the Castroville Library.
 - Eric Becerra motioned to approve; Tatiana Roganova seconded; no discussion; 7 out of 7 in favor; motion carried
 - Action Item: Vote to approve new position at Salinas Adult School: SAS would like to use carryover funds to hire a full-time Database Specialist. Plan to use carryover for first year, and then use new AEBG funds plus other funding sources (LCFF if necessary).
 - Jeff Lopez motioned to approve; Steve James seconded; no discussion; 6 in favor, 1 against (MCOE); motion carried
- New Workgroups and Revised Steering Meeting Schedule
 - At the September Designee Retreat, it was agreed that the work of the Consortium could be accomplished more efficiently and effectively by forming a new Accountability Workgroup and reinstating the Planning Workgroup, in addition to the active Data Workgroup (PPT showed the tasks of each workgroup). With work being done in small groups, there can be fewer Steering Committee Meetings throughout the year. All formal decisions will continue to be made at the open and public Steering Meetings.
 - Action Item: Vote to approve revised Steering Meeting Schedule to only 4-5 meetings per year (unless additional are needed).
 - New meeting dates: November 29, 2017, February 28, 2018 and April 25, 2018
 - Meetings will be from 2:30 5:30 P.M. with the following agenda: 2:30 3:00 P.M. public discussion and program updates and announcements; 3:00 5:00 P.M. action Items and other business; 5:00 5:30 P.M. networking
 - Emily Tsai-Brownfield motioned to approve; Jeff Lopez seconded; 7 out of 7 in favor; motion carried.

• Fiscal Administration

- Local and State-level updates
 - State is developing a new fiscal system for AEBG; more information to come.
 - Members will be submitting budgets, expenditures, and activities directly to the State with the new system.
 - Just learned that a portion of the 5% admin will now need to be used for oversight activities; more information to come, but could include external auditors or peer review.
- Shared Funds: Director wants to discourage use of Member allocations for collaborative activities for which Shared Funds are already earmarked, so we can stick to set plans and budgets.

- Shared Funds for Professional Development
 - We currently have \$15,000 in Shared Funds allotted for professional development. Want to make sure every district has a chance to send at least one person to important conferences like CATESOL and CCAE. Members were encouraged to include PD in their own plans for their own allocations, and most did, however there are shared funds set aside for this, as well.
 - Could vote to approve funding for specific conferences, or divide funds up for Members to use as they wish. Decided to vote to allocate funds for Members to use as they wish, as long as they are allowable uses.
 - Action Item: Vote to divide \$15,000 of Shared Consortium Funds for Professional Development activities (including but not exclusively for attendance of CATESOL and CCAE conferences)
 - Eric Becerra motioned for \$2,000 to be given to Soledad, South Monterey County, MCOE, Hartnell, Gonzalez, and North Monterey County, and \$3,000 to Salinas (Salinas is larger) for professional development, to be revisited at the February meeting to see if funds are being spent or not; Jeff Lopez seconded; no further discussion; 4 out of 7 in favor, 3 out of 7 against (Salinas, MCOE, and South Monterey County); motion did NOT carry.
 - Maricela Cruz motioned for \$1,800 to be given to Soledad, South Monterey County, MCOE, Hartnell, Gonzalez, and North Monterey County, and \$4,200 to Salinas for professional development, to be revisited at the February meeting to see if funds are being spent or not; Tatiana Roganova seconded; no further discussion; 7 out of 7 in favor; motion carried.

Data Workgroup

- Special Projects updates
 - Jennifer Suttie: October 9th and 10th there will be a CASAS Assessment and TE training
 - Gonzalez has their eCASAS testing set up and if you would like to send students to be tested. They will start giving eHiSET by the end of the year. MCOE just got approved to be a HiSET testing facility - will be going through that training.
 - Aidee Farias: Community Needs Assessment Survey still in development, should be ready in November. Members and Partners will have an opportunity to review and give feedback.
 - Aidee Farias: Environmental scan coming along, still collecting data.
 - AWD Transitions Research Project: Justin and Debra from MCOE still conducting research; report should be done by December.
 - We should share intake and assessment tools with community partners like libraries; they would like to be part of the process and be aligned with us.
